**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Springfield Cardinals wrap up the 2008 regular season, with the final game of a three-game series at Dickey-Stephens Park in North Little Rock.

**VS. THE TRAVELERS:** This marks the final series between the two clubs in the regular season. Springfield holds a 17-10 advantage in the series this year, but is just 6-7 at Dickey-Stephens Park in North Little Rock. The Cards just swept a three-game series from the Travs at Hammons Field last weekend.

**JUSTIN FISKE:** Making his 26th appearance and tenth career start...sixth appearance and second start vs the Travs...in last outing, allowed just one run on five hits over six innings in a win over Tulsa on 8/27 at Hammons Field...against the Travs this year, is 1-0 with a 2.31 ERA, allowing three runs on nine hits over 11 2/3 innings...started the 2008 season in Quad Cities, with no record and a 5.40 ERA in 11 relief outings...was moved to Palm Beach, where he allowed one run on one hit over three outings (4 1/3 innings)...in 2007, split time between the Joliet Jackhammers of the Independent Northern League, where he went 0-0 with a 4.50 ERA in four relief appearances...after becoming a Cardinal, was assigned to Batavia of the NY-Penn League, going 2-0 with a 1.03 ERA in 15 relief outings...played in college at Texas State University...originally signed by the St. Louis Cardinals out of the Independent Northern League on 7/3/07...**ROBERT MOSEBACH:** Making his 29th start and sixth against Springfield in 2008...is 1-3 with an 8.06 ERA vs Springfield this year, allowing 26 runs (23 earned) on 40 hits over 25 2/3 innings...in last start, allowed three runs on six hits over seven innings in a loss vs NWA on 8/27...spent most of 2007 in Rancho Cucamonga of the California League, where he was 11-7 with 4.28 ERA in 25 games (23 starts)...originally drafted by Angels in 9th round of 2005 June Draft out of Hillsborough Community College in Florida.

**LAST GAME:** Wil Ortiz doubled home Coby Smith to break a 3-3 fifth-inning tie, as the Arkansas Travelers knocked off the Springfield Cardinals by a score of 5-3 on Sunday night at Dickey-Stephens Park in North Little Rock. Cards' starter Kyle Mura gave up five runs (two earned) over 4 1/3 innings in the loss. David Austen gave up three runs, scattering 11 hits over six innings in the win for the Travs. Allen Craig, Brett Wallace, Mark Shorey, Brandon Buckman and Isa Garcia all had two hits each for Springfield, which out-hit Arkansas 12-10.

**CONGRATS TO THE "NATS":** The Northwest Arkansas Naturals' 7-3 win over the Tulsa Drillers on Saturday afternoon gave the Naturals the Second Half North Division Title and also eliminated the Springfield Cardinals from playoff contention. The Naturals will meet the Arkansas Travelers in the opening game of the Texas League North Division Finals, this Tuesday, at Dickey-Stephens Park in North Little Rock.

**MOVING FORWARD:** Now that the Cardinals have been officially eliminated from the 2008 playoff hunt, we look forward to the 2009 season. We hope you're able to join us at Hammons Field on Thursday, April 9th, 2009, as your Springfield Cardinals host the Frisco RoughRiders for Opening Day of the Texas League Season. On behalf of all of us with the Springfield Cardinals, **THANK YOU** to all the fans, sponsors, employees and members of the Cardinals' family. 2008 has been an incredibly special season and we couldn't have done it without your support. Don't forget to pick up a 2009 pocket schedule at the main office at Hammons Field. We hope to see you again at Hammons Field in 2009!

**SOUTH SHOW-DOWN:** The Midland RockHounds are now just one win away from reaching the 2008 Texas League Playoffs. Midland's 3-2 win over Frisco last night, puts them one game up over Frisco in the second half standings. Should Frisco beat Midland in today's season-finale, Frisco and Midland would finish with identical second-half marks, with Frisco getting the tie-breaker, thanks to a better head-to-head record. If that scenario played out, that would open the door for San Antonio, who could get into the playoffs as the wild card, by beating Corpus Christi. A San Antonio win and a Midland loss would give both teams identical overall marks, with the Missions advancing to the playoffs due to a better head-to-head record. In a nutshell...it breaks down like this: A Midland win and their in. A Midland loss and a San Antonio, sends San Antonio to the playoffs. The winner will head to Frisco on Wednesday to open the South Division Playoffs.

**WRAPPING UP 2008:** The Cardinals have already set a franchise record with 76 wins this year, the second highest total in the Texas League this year. The Cards finished with a record of 38-32 at home this year, three wins shy of the record of 41, set in 2005. The Redbirds have already set a franchise record with 38 road wins and still one to play.

**RED-HOT "RAP":** Jim Rapoport has hit safely in nine straight and 12 of his last 13. On Friday night, Rapoport had a walk-off single for the game-winner. Saturday night, he knocked in Springfield's second run in the sixth, which technically represented the second straight night that he's knocked in the game-winner. Rapoport has raised his average to .235 entering today's final game.

**7, 8 AND 9:** The Springfield Cardinals have three members in the Texas League's top 10 for batting average. Jon Jay at .308 is #7, Allen Craig at .304 is #8 and Mark Shorey is just percentage points behind at #9, also with .304 average. Tulsa's Matt Miller, who was promoted to Triple-A less than a month ago, looks to have the batting crown wrapped up with a .344 average.

**TEAM LEADERS IN 2008:** Allen Craig will end up leading the Cardinals in a number of categories. Currently, he's first in doubles with 30, 22 homers, 85 RBIs, 48 walks and 129 games played. Jon Jay, now of Memphis, leads the club with a .309 average. Tyler Greene has 14 steals currently, to lead the club.

**WHAT DIDN'T HAPPEN IN 2008:** Sure there's one more game to play, but in four years of franchise history, we still haven't seen any Cardinal throw a perfect game or a no-hitter. Offensively, no Cardinal has hit an inside-the-park home run and no Cardinal has hit for the cycle. Defensively, we're also still waiting for our first triple-play in franchise history.

**KINNEY ON THE ROAD:** Josh Kinney, a member of the 2005 Inaugural Springfield Cardinals Team, has made a total of three rehab appearances for Springfield. Kinney allowed his first base hit in Friday's appearance, but retired the next three hitters to record his third scoreless innings in his three appearances. The very first Springfield Cardinal in franchise history to go on and make his debut in the Major Leagues for the St. Louis Cardinals, Kinney went 5-2 with 11 saves and a 1.29 ERA in 32 games for Springfield in 2005. He made six scoreless post-season appearances with St. Louis in 2006, helping the Cardinals win their tenth World Series Title. Kinney had "Tommy John" surgery in 2007 and is scheduled to pitch out of the Springfield bullpen again in today's season-finale.

**ANGELS IN ARKANSAS:** The Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim have only two prospects in Arkansas which Baseball America considers to be in the top 30 Angels prospects overall. They include #11 INF Hainley Statia and #19 OF Chris Pettit.
